- *Location (surrounding community) and Size (school population)
- *Living Accommodations (residence halls and off campus housing)
- *Scholarship Opportunities and total cost (tuition, room and board)
- *Level of Athletic Participation (Division I, II, or III)



Summer School

If your child anticipates having to attend summer school, please be aware of the following guidelines:

- 1. All courses must be approved by the counselor.
- 2. Summer school credit will not be accepted without the "HHS Summer School Review Course Approval" form (available in the guidance office).
- 3. Students are permitted to attend the approved summer schools, listed below. Specific applications and approval forms for each school are required in addition to the HHS summer school approval form.
