#### **Cynthia Randina, Hopatcong Superintendent of Schools, Announces -**

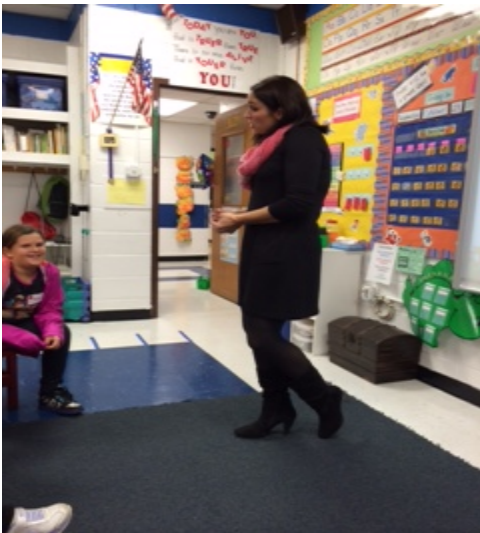
