Dear Parents and/or Guardians:

## WHEN MAY MY CHILD RETURN TO SCHOOL AFTER ILLNESS?

Your child may not return to school until the following criteria has been met:

- 1. Fever free <u>over a 72\* hour period</u> without needing anti-fever medication (such as Tylenol/Motrin/etc.)
- 2. No vomiting or diarrhea for a 72\* hour period.
- 3. Appetite and activity levels have returned to normal.
- 4. Any symptoms should <u>not</u> interfere with participation in the school day or infect others.
- 5. After at least <u>72\* hours</u> of antibiotic therapy for any infectious condition such as strep throat, pink eye, etc. This is provided that your child has <u>also</u> been fever free during this time period.

Your cooperation will ensure the health and safety of our entire school community.

When your child is ready to return to school after an illness, feel free to call the school nurse. She would be happy to assist you in deciding what is best for your child.
