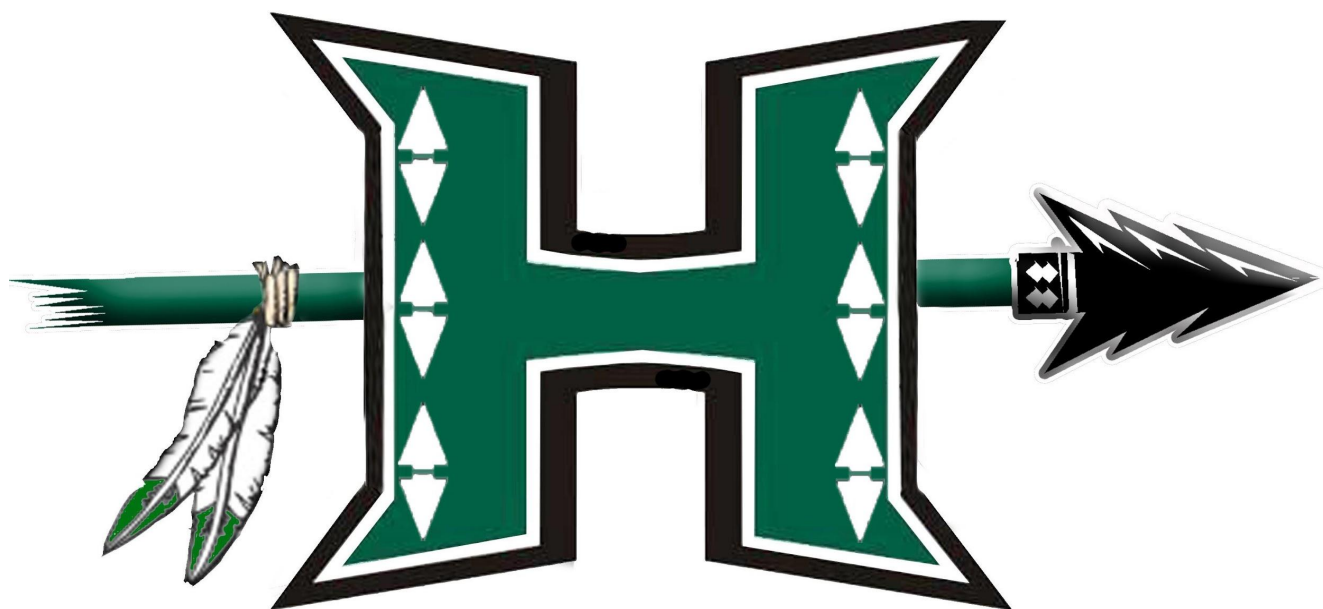

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS AND INSTRUCTOR

Math is Fun

Instructor - Diana Pinto (Durban Ave. teacher)

Students will be able to use their curiosity to complete thought-provoking tasks that promote exploration and friendships through the use of teamwork. They will be able to connect problem-solving skills to real world math concepts such as addition, subtraction, measurement, data analysis and more. Students will use math skills and engineering knowledge to complete math tasks, enjoy the process and come to a fun conclusion. Students will learn to work as a team, depend on others, cooperate with each other and listen to the ideas of others. Movement will be integrated into every day to either test a hypothesis, estimate or observe something new. (limit of 16 students)

Art

Instructor Jonathon Rischawy (HHS Art teacher)

Art Camp is for students entering grades 3 through 8 and focuses on project based instruction with an emphasis on fun. Students will work on a variety of projects that utilize an assortment of media, including painting, drawing, sculpture, ceramics and more.

STEAM

Instructor - Dana DeMetro (Durban Ave. teacher)

STEAM Summer Camp is a great way to focus on sparking imagination and creativity through the arts in ways that naturally align to STEAM learning.

Students will use their curiosity to ask thought-provoking questions that promote creativity and exploration. They will work on connecting their problem-solving skills to real world situations. They will use math skills and engineering knowledge to connect to new things. They will engage in teamwork and cooperative learning ventures. (limit 16 students)

Cosmetology

Instructor - Heather Bivone (HHS Cosmetology teacher)

Students will be able to perform basic wet and dry hairstyling techniques such as braids, pincurls, rollers, blow drying, curling, flat iron techniques and many different updo techniques. Students will understand and perform proper facials and massage techniques. Students will gain knowledge of nail care, understand and perform manicuring and nail art techniques. HHS Cosmo students are welcome to join in and make up hours required for certification.

Maker Space

Instructor - Danielle Tromba (Randolph Twp. teacher)

Maker Space Summer Camp is a destination where students can create, problem solve, develop skills, talents and thinking all while using mental rigor. It will help foster innovation through hands-on experimentation, practice creativity skills and apply personalized learning strategies to make changes of existing concepts and develop their own ideas, methods or products. Activities include: experimenting with construction methods, problem solving via trial and error, using curiosity to demonstrate life-long learning, team activities to learn cooperation and listening skills. (limit of 16 students)

Social Emotional Learning

Instructors- Amanda Maliszewski (Tulsa Trail teacher, Carolyn Segura, Tulsa Trail para.)

This eight day, two week course will help all styles of students learn about different emotions and how they can successfully navigate these emotions. The Little Spot of Emotion curriculum, which is perfect for students who might struggle to control their emotions both in school and at home, will be utilized. Students will learn through stories, activities and peer interactions guided by the teacher. Social skills will be worked on during snack time.

Sports Mania

Instructor Craig Vallero, (HHS teacher, Head Soccer Coach)

Themes of the following sports include:

Volleyball - with a tournament for age appropriate students; Kickball; Flag Football; Baseball, Softball; Basketball skills competition, team matchups; Soccer; Badminton and Ping Pong, Relay Races; Super-soaker tag; Four Square team matchups.

Drama

Instructor, Kerri Batche (HHS, Drama, Musical Coordinator)

Students will learn how to perform in a theatrical production culminating in a July 20th evening performance at the HHS auditorium. Students who are not available on that date should not register. (limit of 16 students)

Intro to Crochet

Instructor, Kathryn Gallagher (HHS and HMS teacher)

Students will learn the basics of crochet including terminology, how to read a pattern and basic stitches. Students will be provided with supplies.

Fashion Design

Instructor - Shelby Ochs - (Hopatcong para and substitute)

Students will learn about the fashion industry, fashion sketching and rendering, how to make a pattern and how to bring designs together to make a wearable garment. Each student will design and make their own circle skirt that will debut in a runway show at the end of the week. They will also go home with a fashion portfolio. (limit of 10 students)
