Scholarship Awards

Scholarships are awarded annually and depend upon the financial resources and budgetary restraints of Sparta UNICO. This spring, Sparta UNICO will be awarding \$1,000.00 scholarships for the school year 2020-2021

Applicants will be judged based on academic achievement, financial need, SAT or ACT scores, extracurricular activities, community service, and citizenship. Once received, the scholarship committee will review each applicant's submission and select this year's winners. Announcement of the awards will be made at the discretion of the Board of Trustees.

The Scholarship Committee will review the timely submitted application and award scholarships impartially. Applications for the 2020-2021 school year must be received by June 1, 2021. Announcements of the awards are made thereafter.

Scholarship Criteria

Applications are limited to high school seniors who:

- 1. Will graduate by August 31, 2021.
- 2. From a Sussex County high school.
- 3. Applicant is pursuing higher education or training beyond high school on a

full-time basis.

4. Applicant must have exhibited good community service and citizenship traits and be of good moral character.

2. A one-page double spaced narrative summarizing your financial needs, qualities, community service, future studies, and plans for your education and why you are requesting a scholarship from Unico.

3. A high school transcript from your guidance office with GPA, SAT OR ACT scores, classes taken and rank in class.

4. One reference from your school principal, counselor, teacher, coach or employer.

5. On a separate piece of paper, a list of all extracurricular and community activities you have engaged in the past three years. Include the activity, dates of participation, hours per week engaged in the activity and whether you have received any awards. A complete resume of your extracurricular activities and work experience may be substituted to meet this requirement.

6. On a separate piece of paper, a list of all your work experience giving the job, employer, hours worked per week. Also include work you plan to do for next summer. A complete resume of your extracurricular activities and work experience may be substituted to meet this requirement.

Applications that are incomplete and/or lack the requested information may disqualify the student from consideration.
