Finding Your Career Path?

Application Process

Students must submit an Internship Application to Mrs. Kalemba, Career Internship Coordinator. Career Internship mentors can be in the district or in the community. Our current job placements include, but are not limited to: accounting/business, law enforcement, physical fitness, disability services, medical, marketing, real estate, public relations, film production/videography, and music production.



Mission

Hopatcong High School students have the chance to learn about potential careers and the responsibilities associated with them. Students must will be matched with an outside or district mentor in the career area in which they are interested. Interactions with students and mentors usually will be outside of the school day.



Additional Program Information

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required for program participation.
- Students must arrange for transportation to and from the internship site.



Internship Credit & Grading

Students can earn 2.5 or 5 credits for career internships toward elective credit to fulfill graduation requirements. Students may also become involved in unpaid internships over the summer. Actual letter grades for successful completion will be issued instead of pass/fail grades that were issued in the past. Additionally, career internships will not count toward the community service graduation requirement for the Class of 2018 and beyond.
