- Essays should be attached to this cover sheet and should be labeled with only the applicant's student number.
- Two scholarships of \$500 each will be awarded, one to a student at Hopatcong High School and one to a student at Lenape Valley High School
- The deadline is 2:00pm on Friday, March 31st.
- Applications for the Hopatcong High School scholarship will be submitted to Mrs. Yanko. Applications will then be forwarded as blind submissions (with no identifying information) to Mrs. Carolyn Segura.
- Submissions will be the determining factor on who will be awarded the scholarship.
