HHS Paint Your Parking Spot

• How much?

- o \$35 total
 - \$10 for the usual parking spot fee (paid to the School directly).
 - \$25 to participate in the "Paint Your Parking Spot Fundraiser" (separate payment to Project Grad '25.
- o BYOP (Bring Your Own Paint).

When?

- August 26-28. (will have additional days after school starts)
- 8am 10am (register for parking spot), painting to take place once approved.
- First come, first serve in terms of picking spots
- You MUST first apply for and be approved for a parking spot permit with Mrs. Amella
 - If you can do that ahead of time, prior to 8/26, it will save you time in picking out your spot.
 - All approved permits MUST be presented before being allowed to paint.

• Where?

- We will fill the lot at the bottom of the stairs by the gym FIRST!
- We will then fill the larger lot by the trail to the civic center as needed
- Staff members from ALL schools will also indicate if they want their spot painted, and students
 can then sign up to paint their spot for them, based on the colors/design the staff member wants
 (staff will pay the fee, students can paint the spots).
 - More details to follow on that...

Rules?

- Anyone applying for a parking spot MUST have already taken the Share The Keys course offered by the school (Next available course is 8/14/24)
- ALL designs MUST have a four inch, unpainted border around the parking spot design (cannot paint over parking spot lines or numbers). ANY inappropriate designs will warrant surrender of the reserved space, as well as a forfeiture of the fee (no refunds) and will be painted over immediately.
- Any profanity or symbols associated with gangs, drugs, alcohol, guns, sex, and/or promote violence are strictly prohibited. Handicap symbols or any design that may be confused with official parking signage is also prohibited.
 - Any inappropriate spots will be painted over with black and the student will not have the ability to re-paint their spot.
- The student's initials and Class ('25 or '26) MUST be included in the design.

- Students will be required to bring supplies such as brushes, rollers, sponges, tape, chalk, etc.
 Sprayers and spray cans are prohibited. Again, all spots MUST ensure a four-inch unpainted border is kept.
- Students are responsible for supplying their own paint. Any color is allowed, however ALL paint must be water based LATEX exterior paint (this will be checked and approved before painting can begin).
- Painting will occur on designated "Paint Days". This is when students should make themselves available to paint. Spots must be blackened out first by YOU before you begin. This will take some time to dry. Keep this in mind. You must not paint over any lines that delineate parking spaces or numbers.
- Reserved staff spaces will be open to the public after school hours, on weekends, and on days off.
- Anyone who parks in a reserved parking space that is not theirs will have their school parking privileges suspended for one week.
- As any other students age in or apply for a parking spot after school start can speak to Mrs.
 Amella and reach out to the Project Grad '25 committee for rules and approval to paint after school or a weekend.
- Students are reminded that all district policies and local laws will be enforced in the student parking lots. Participation in the fundraising program and reservation of student parking spaces does not exclude any vehicle from being subject to applicable policies, procedures, practices, codes, or law. Administration reserves the right to revoke reservation status and any associated privileges, without refund, for any infractions deemed significant by administrators.
- All supplies and clean up are the responsibility of the student.
 - Cash, check (made out to HHS Project Grad 2025), or venmo (send to @Matt-Mood-1 and indicate HHS parking Spot Painting in the description with your students name) will be accepted and must be paid before any painting can begin.
